**4** During the fall semester, **77%** of students were enrolled in undergraduate academic degree programs, **22%** were in graduate degree programs, and **1%** was enrolled in certificate programs. **57%** of students were enrolled as majors in the School of Nursing; **15%** in the School of Arts and Sciences and **28%** in the School of Health Professions (this includes enrollment in non-degree programs).

**5** **26 years old** is the average age of a FranU student

79% percent of the student body is under 30 years of age, and 7% is over 40 years of age.

**9** FranU employed **89** full-time faculty members (both 10-month and 12-month contract), laboratory instructors/coordinators, and draws as needed from a pool of well qualified professionals who serve as adjunct faculty.

FranU constituencies are served by **84** professional and support staff members in enrollment services, academic affairs, counseling, financial aid, business affairs, development, institutional effectiveness, library, technology, and administrative support positions including extra duty Baton Rouge police officers and non-work study student workers.
